

Japan Public-Private Council on Dementia

- Based on common understanding that issues concerning dementia should be tackled by society as a whole, it was established on April 22, 2019, aiming for promoting necessary measures with collaboration among public administration as well as private entities such as economic organizations, medical and welfare organizations, local governments, academic society and so on.

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- Approx. 100 organizations from following sectors joined.

- Working groups are set up under the council to discuss details based on perspectives of persons with dementia and their families.
